

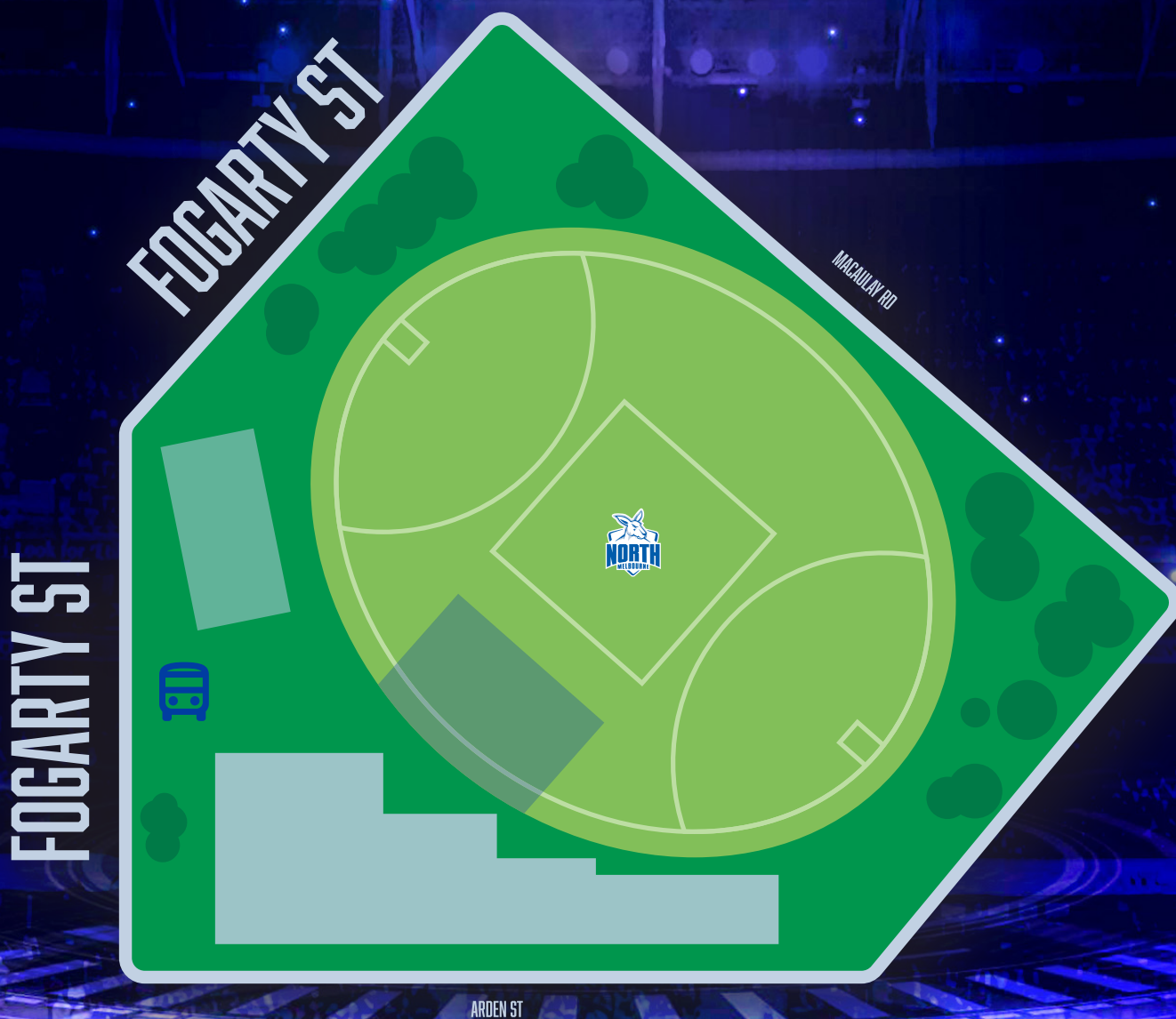


GAME DAY

WHAT TO EXPECT

Arrival and departure:

- ▷ Game Day is designed to begin at **9.45am** and conclude at **2.30pm**.
- ▷ If you need to adjust either of these times, please email us at education@thehuddle.org.au to let us know before the day.
- ▷ Unfortunately, there is no designated bus zone at The Huddle. We recommend drop-off and pick-up along Fogarty St, next to the outdoor futsal court.

WHAT TO EXPECT

Getting here by public transport:

The Huddle is easily accessible by public transport!

- 🚉 North Melbourne and Macaulay train stations are both a 15-minute walk from The Huddle
- 🚌 Take Route 57 and get off at stop 14 or 15 for a 10-minute walk to The Huddle

Entrance:

WHAT TO EXPECT

Starting the day:

Our staff will endeavour to meet you outside, but in the event they do not, please proceed to the North Melbourne Football Club reception desk (the blue and white one!) and they will let us know you have arrived.

Please sit your students on the floor in front of the Premiership Cups while you wait for The Huddle staff member to greet you.

Student groups:

- ▷ Students will be split into six even groups upon arrival.
- ▷ Please feel free to organise the groups beforehand. If you choose to do so, please note that there must be **six groups**, with no group being larger than **five students**.
- ▷ Alternatively, our facilitators will organise the groups with a random allocation.

WHAT TO EXPECT

Break times:

- ▷ Students will be given a 15-minute recess break and a 45-minute lunch break.
- ▷ Recess will take place inside The Huddle classroom.
- ▷ Weather permitting, your lunch break will take place outside on the futsal court. We will provide you with a bag of sports equipment to use during this break.

Supervision:

We would appreciate your support with any behaviour management issues that arise throughout the day but rest assured that our experienced facilitators will take the reins of program delivery once you arrive. We will handball back to you at break times, but outside of that, feel free to take a step back and enjoy the day.

Tea and coffee facilities:

Our friendly facilitators will show you where you can make yourself a cup of tea or coffee when you arrive. Please feel free to access these facilities at any point during your visit.

Roo Squad flyers:

All students who attend Game Day will be provided with a QR code that they can use to sign up for a Roo Squad membership, which will entitle them to 4 free children's tickets to a North Melbourne AFL home game. To encourage them to take advantage of this offer, we will also provide you with a class set of Roo Squad flyers and ask you to distribute them to your students once you arrive back at school.
